## GIRL SCOUT TROOP DONATES PORTION OF COOKIE SALES TO ENVIRONMENTAL NATURE CENTER

ENC Executive Director will accept donation, which will help create a new Nature Play Area and Garden

**Newport Beach, Calif., May 26, 2015** – On May 29 at 4:30PM, Carden Academy Girl Scout Troop #3367 will hand deliver a donation check to Environmental Nature Center (ENC) Executive Director Bo Glover. The donation is a portion of the troop's cookie sales profits. The funds will help the ENC create a new Nature Play area - an outdoor natural classroom where children can play and learn – as well as an organic food garden at the Center's future Nature Preschool.

"We are on a garden journey this year," said Troop #3367 Leader Carolyn Posey. "We wanted our donation to go to something related to gardening, like a children's garden, and we are thrilled that the ENC can use our donation to help create a Nature Play area and Organic Food Garden for the ENC's future Nature Preschool."

All 16 scouts in the troop will be on hand to deliver the check. The girls will then pitch their tents, start a campfire, and cook a celebratory meal to commemorate the end of their scouting year. An ENC Naturalist will facilitate games, tell stories around the campfire, and lead a night hike for the girls.

"Right now all of the donations coming in for the Nature Preschool and Nature Play Area are being doubled by a local philanthropist," said Glover. "Troop #3367's gift comes at the perfect time to make the biggest impact!"
