ENVIRONMENTAL NATURE CENTER PRESENTS: AN EVENING WITH CHRIS EPTING

On Saturday, June 7, from 4-6PM, the Environmental Nature Center will host a special event featuring acclaimed New York Times bestselling author Chris Epting, who will present the dramatic and rarely told story of the Bolsa Chica Gun Club—a luxurious 19th-century hunting retreat that forever changed the Southern California coastline.

Based on his book *The Bolsa Chica Gun Club: A History*, Epting will guide attendees through the opulent rise and environmental fall of the wetland site, revealing how elite industrialists manipulated land and water for sport and status—ultimately prompting ecological damage that took over a century to undo.

The talk will explore how community activism and science led to the site's stunning restoration in 2006, and what it teaches us about today's ongoing battles over natural resources, access, and conservation.

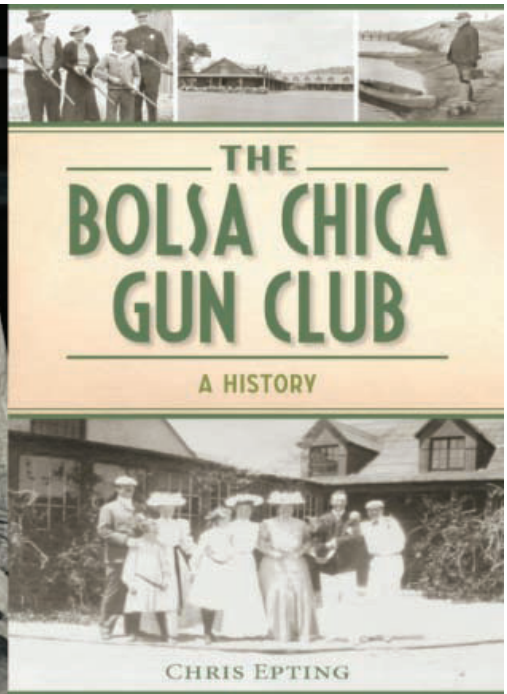
